## From the Mayor's Office

### Twelve (12) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

October 28, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Tuesday, October 27, there are twelve (12) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, six-hundred and thirty-four (2634) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. **Two thousand, three-hundred and eighty (2380) people have recovered from the virus.** An additional forty-eight (48) persons have been quarantined. The total amount of persons who have been quarantined since the pandemic began is six-thousand, three-hundred and three (6303). Five thousand, seven-hundred and fifty-five (5755) people are now out of quarantine. **There are no new deaths to report.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and seventeen (117).
