Sixteen (16) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

November 5, 2020

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update on Wednesday, November 4, there are sixteen (16) new COVID-19 cases to report, bringing our total to two thousand, seven-hundred and forty-one (2741) confirmed cases since the pandemic began. An additional thirty-six (36) persons have been quarantined. The total amount of persons who have been quarantined since the pandemic began is six-thousand, six-hundred and fourteen (6614). **There are no new deaths to report.** The total number of fatalities stands at one hundred and seventeen (117).

Cases in our city are rising. Cold and flu season is upon us, so the virus is now more easily hidden with symptoms of other common, less dangerous illnesses. I encourage you to get tested for COVID-19 if you are experiencing cold and flu symptoms that overlap with COVID-19 symptoms. Extreme caution will get us safely through the fall and winter season, and isolating COVID-19 will help to prevent the spread of the virus. Please also continue to wear your face masks and practice social distancing while in public and around people that are not a part of your household.

In partnership with Union County, the City of Plainfield will provide residents with free COVID-19 tests and flu shots. The next date to get your flu shot is **tomorrow**, **Friday**, **November 6 from 9:00AM-2:00PM** at **the Gerald B. Green Building**, **200 West 2nd Street**. COVID-19 tests will be administered on **Saturday**, **November 7 from 1:00PM-4:00PM at the Faith Christian Outreach Center**, **533 West 5**th **Street**.

Stay safe and may God continue to bless each of you.
